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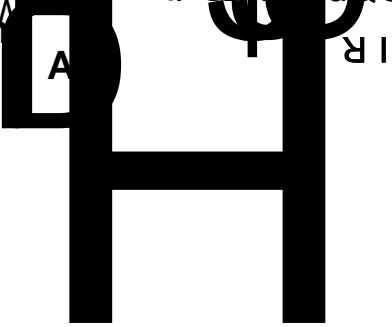

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16 hours per week minimum (14 hours at the site and 2 hours in practicum seminar class)

14 weeks each term (28 weeks for a year)

224 hours per term, minimum (448 hours for the academic year)

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20 hours per week minimum (18 hours at the site and 2 hours in practicum seminar class)

14 weeks each term (28 weeks for a year)

280 hours per term, minimum (560 hours for the academic year)

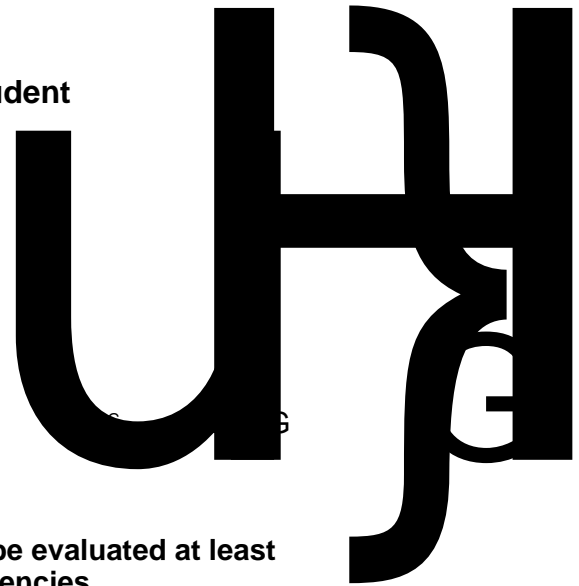

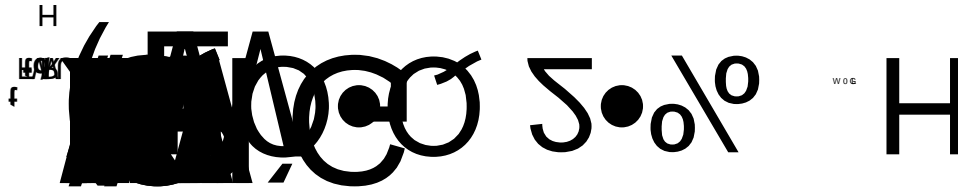
