Apply to the Master of Social Work program at George Fox University. The program is designed to prepare students for professional social work practice and leadership in a variety of settings.

The Master of Social Work program is a two-year, full-time program. Students are required to complete 36 credit hours of coursework, including a thesis. The program is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE). The curriculum is designed to provide students with the knowledge, skills, and values necessary to practice social work effectively and ethically.

Students in the Master of Social Work program will benefit from the university's commitment to excellence in education and research. The program offers a variety of opportunities for students to gain practical experience through internships and field placements. The faculty is composed of experienced social workers who are committed to providing high-quality instruction and mentorship.

Admission Requirements: Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required. Applicants must also submit a resume, a letter of recommendation, and a personal statement. The personal statement should describe the applicant's interest in social work and their career goals. The admissions committee will review all applications and make a decision based on the applicant's qualifications.

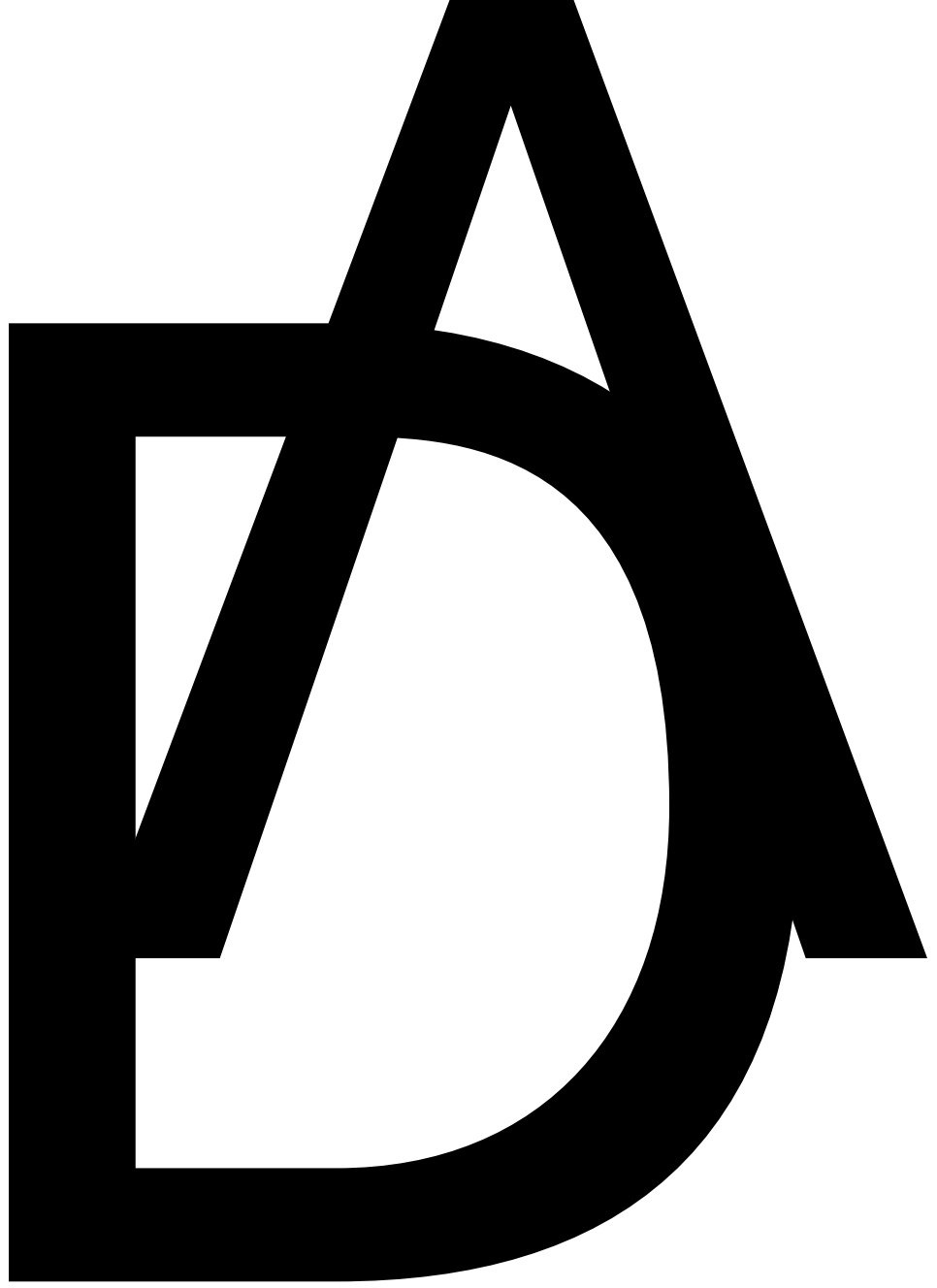

George Fox University is a Christian university committed to the pursuit of truth and the promotion of the Kingdom of God. We are proud to be part of a community that values excellence in education and service to others.

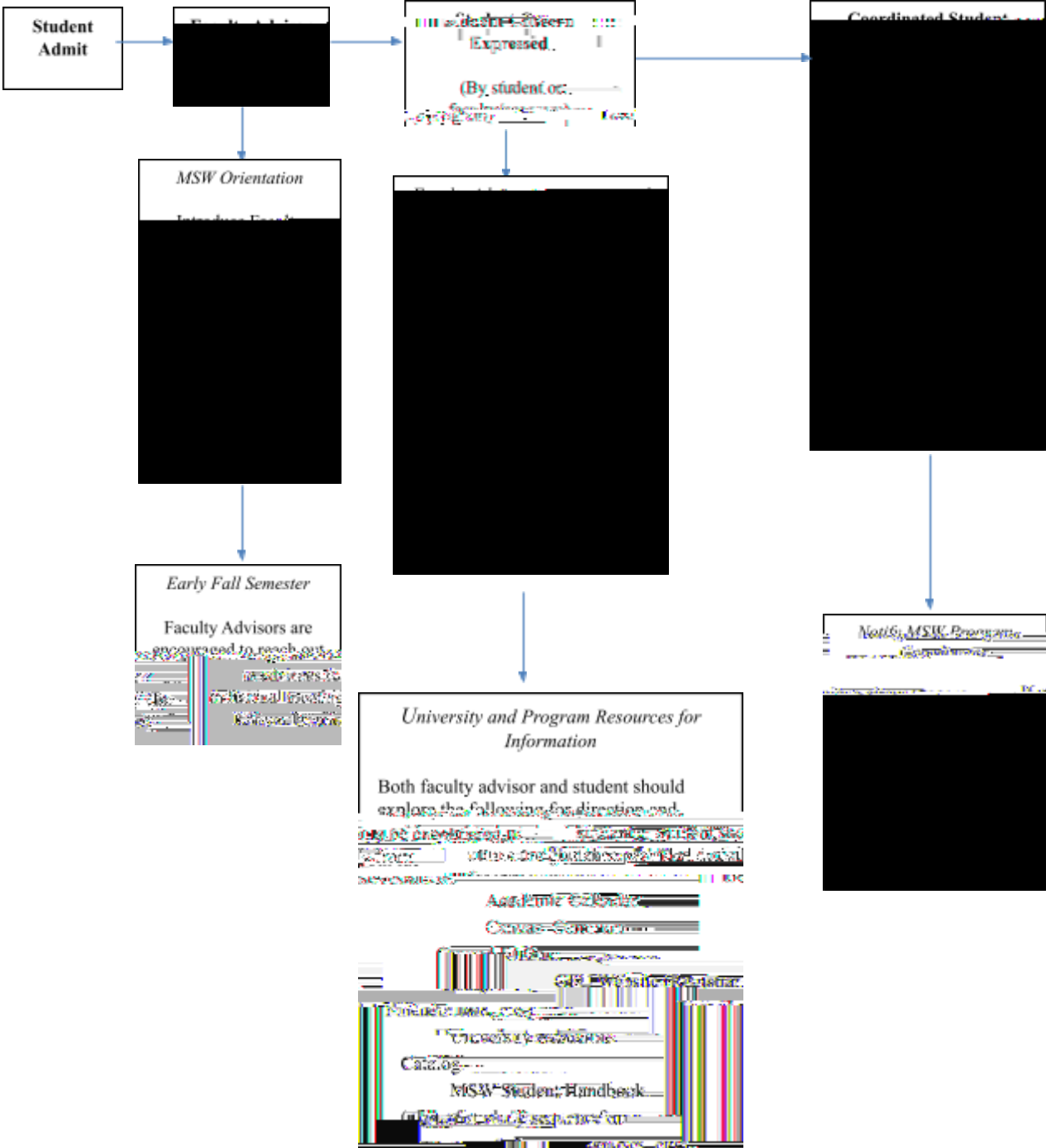
